## USER MANUAL GUIDE

RIBEN Stainless Steel Refuse Chute Hopper (Grade 304)

- 1. To ensure the chute is tightly closed-up, you will need to push firmly right above the 'R' logo's latch till it is completely locked due to the rubber is slightly higher than the door.
- 2. Always keep the chute (both inner and outer surface) dry to avoid oxidation caused by water. You may remove with WD-40 if corrosion is found.
- 3. Do not wash with soap or detergent on the entire chute area. Refrain pouring oil or water into the chute as different chemical compounds will affect the stainless steel to corrode and will cause a breakdown of the rubber seal over a period of time.
- 4. Using paint brush to brush off debris on all surrounding of the rubber seal every quarterly (3 months).
- 5. Two (2) years warranty based on manufacturing defects.

## COMPANY POLICY:

Warranty will be invalidated if chute is found misused or lack of proper maintenance.

Basic Maintenance: Use dry cloth to clean the outer surface.
